**On the large bead of each decade:** Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

**On the ten small beads of each decade:** For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

**Conclude with:** Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. *Say three times.*
